


Intermodal hubs from Slovakia to AGCT


New Metrans Service common/public trains connecting Rijeka and Budapest launched in Q2 2023 to be followed up with connection to Dunajska Streda

→ Port of Rijeka multimodal platform development and interconnection to AGCT: 35.6 mil project value

- Extension of the Mediterranean corridor towards Western Balkans – Croatian priority:
 - Inclusion of connection Zagreb - Krapina Pragersko to connect two corridors Mediterranean and Baltic Adriatic
 - Connection to Slovenia via Pivka (mentioned in the **CEF II Regulation as** comprehensive network)
- Special attention on the railway section connecting Rijeka to Hungarian border, consisting of many projects financed from various sources (ERDF + CEF)

- **Modernization** increase of:
 - speed (up to 160 km/h),
 - safety level
 - capacity
 - bottlenecks removal
 - better connection to ports



Luka Rijeka Inland Terminal



- 7 km from AGCT with road and rail access

Advantages of reefers via AGCT

- Reefer storage and monitoring, on dock CFS with direct manipulation from reefers to truck and vice versa
- Reefer block trains can be organized in direct planning with vessel operation enabling full utilization of favorable and competitive transit times towards final inland destinations
- Our partner, Luka Rijeka currently in progress of constructing 6800sqm reefer warehouse at Škrljevo inland terminal, only 7 km from the terminal connected with both highway and railway



AGCT reefer services on terminal

- BIP station presence of the Border Inspection Point at the terminal enables AGCT to be the first port of call and entry point for all cargo of vegetative or animal origin intended for human consumption in compliance with Veterinary and Phytosanitary inspection upon arrival to EU
- EU customs clearance all goods that enter the EU through the container terminal AGCT can be cleared on site
- Reefer container genset mounting, washing and PTI Inspections offered on site











